Ushering	
<input type="checkbox"/>	During performances, ushers aid in creating an enjoyable experience for our patrons. Usher duties include: helping people to their seats, ripping tickets, handing out programmes, tidying the theatre and coat check. General training and at least <u>three</u> 4 hour shifts per run of a regular mainstage show (three weeks) or four shifts for longer runs (sometimes as many as five weeks)
School Group Ushering	
<input type="checkbox"/>	These performances are especially reserved for school groups and take place during the day on weekdays. These shifts require people who love working with children and teaching them about theatre etiquette. Will be required for 4 hour shifts on a sporadic basis throughout the season.
Exhibit Monitors	
<input type="checkbox"/>	During selected shows, a lobby exhibit will be open to the public during the day on weekdays as well as during performances. General training and at least <u>two</u> 4 hour shifts per run of an exhibit.
Promotions	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Occasionally, volunteers are needed to help with preparing promotional materials throughout the season, including mail-outs, poster and brochures. General training and willing to be contacted on a per need basis.
Special Events	
<input type="checkbox"/>	Occasionally throughout the year, ushers are required to aid in the successful running of a special event. This includes greeting patrons, handing out information and showing patrons around the building. General training and willing to be contacted on a per need basis.
